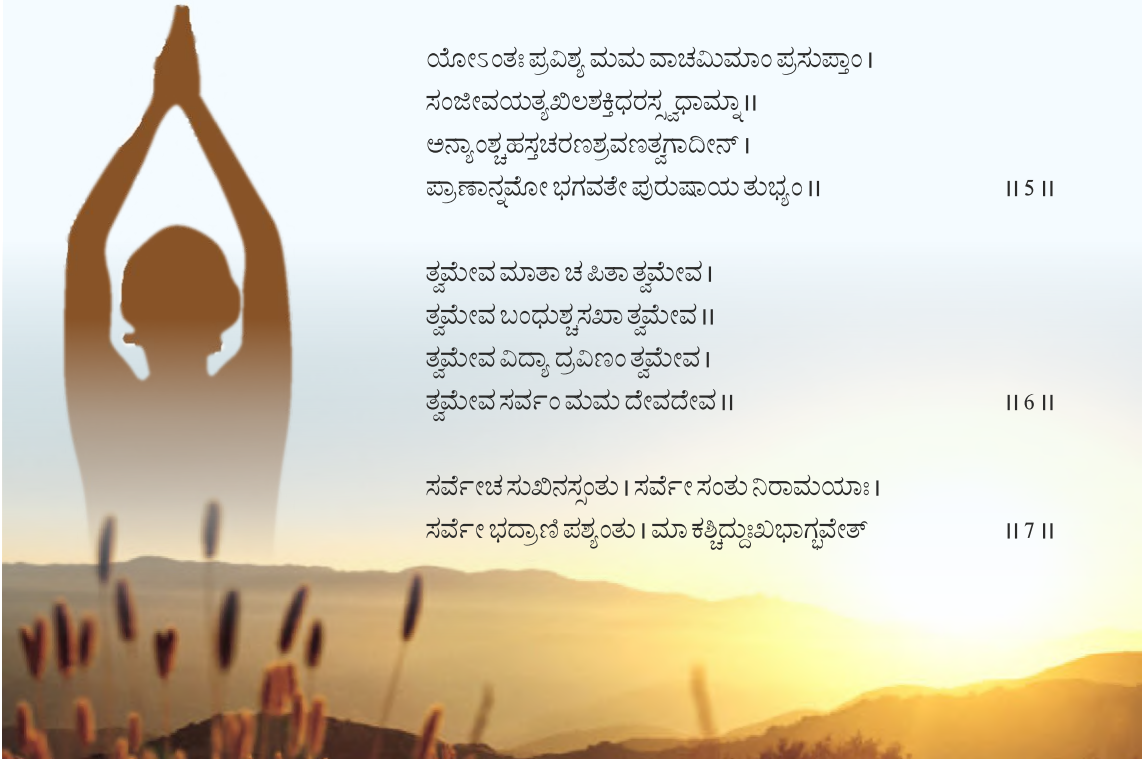

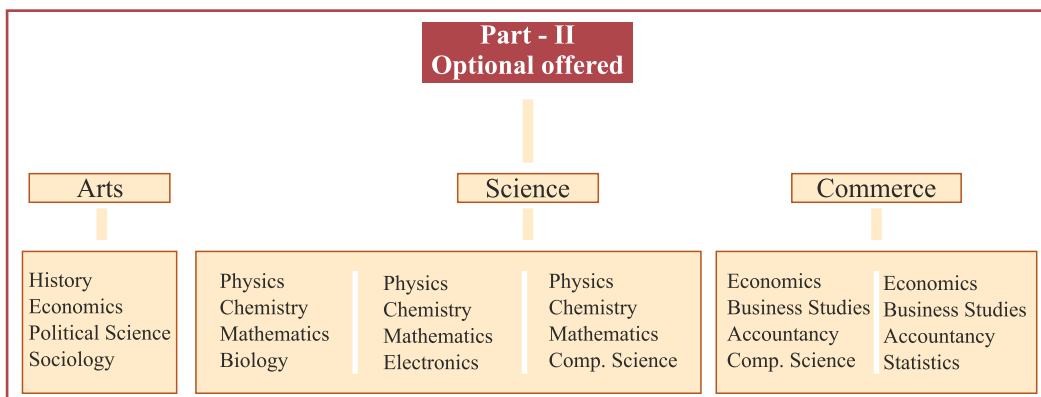
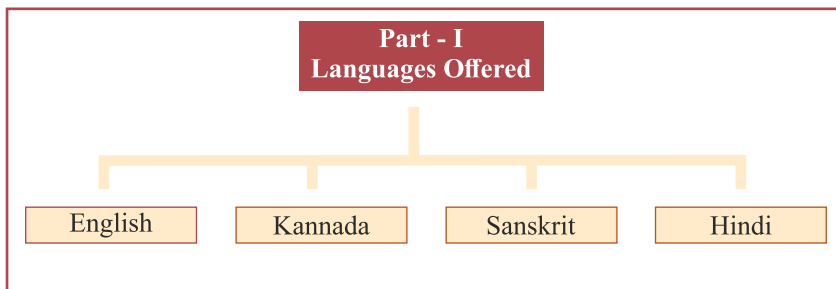

## 4 Rules and Regulations for Admission

1. Application for admission in the prescribed form should reach the Principal on or before the due date specified on the college notice board.
2. **All the benefits and privileges extended by the Govt. to SC/ST/BT and OBC students are made available to them in the college.**
3. Application should be accompanied by attested copies of:
  - a) Transfer Certificate from the Institution last attended.
  - b) Marks Card of the qualifying examination.
  - c) The Medical Examination Certificate from the previous Institution.
4. Only attested copies of the certificates should be enclosed. The originals should be produced at the time of admission.
5. Students coming from other states must submit Migration and Eligibility Certificates.
6. Change of Optional subjects from Science to Arts is permitted. However no such change is permitted from Arts to Science discipline.
7. I Pre-University applicants must choose the same language that they have studied in the previous class.
8. **Fee paid once to the institution will not be refunded on any account.** The fee receipt should be preserved and produced on demand.

9. Names of the students provisionally selected for admission will be displayed on the college Notice Board and the Principal reserves the right of admission.
10. **All admissions are provisional and are subject to the approval by the Department of Pre-University Education.**
11. Incomplete applications will not be entertained.
12. **Students who have arrears of fees and shortage of attendance will not be permitted to submit their application forms to any of the qualifying examinations.**
13. Students selected for admission should affix a passport size photograph in their application and produce 2 extra copies.
7. Students should take their work seriously and respect fellow classmates and teachers and maintain utmost discipline to keep up the dignity and fair name of the institution.
8. No student is permitted to act indecently or involve in any unruly activity with his or her fellow students.
9. If a student is found indulging in any act of indifference he/she may be terminated from the college.
10. Students may normally meet the Principal between 3 & 5 p.m. unless under extraordinary circumstances.
11. Students are instructed to get their documents verified from the college office before meeting the Principal for his/her signature.

## 5 Instructions to Students -----

1. Students must attend classes regularly.
2. 75% attendance is compulsory. **Shortage of attendance below 75% may disqualify the students from appearing the examination.**
3. During leisure, they are advised to make use of the facilities like library, indoor games, or seek academic assistance from teachers.
4. No student should be found loitering in the quadrangle.
5. I.D. Cards must be produced whenever asked for by any of the college authorities.
6. Visitors (parents, friends, etc) may contact the college office for any assistance. Such visitors shall not go to the classrooms for any purpose or be found in the quadrangle unauthorisedly. The authorities reserve the right of interrogating or taking suitable action against such persons.
12. In case there are occasions for any displeasure or complaint, students may feel free to express the same with the authorities directly in person. They are not to seek help on such matters from their fellow classmates or senior students.
13. Students are strictly warned not to meddle with electrical installations or carelessly handle instruments supplied for work. Life is precious and so must be guarded.
14. Scribbling on walls, desks or defacing the building is reprehensible and will attract punishment.
15. Vehicle parking in front of the main gate is prohibited. The Scooter stand must be used to park vehicles to avoid unnecessary problems.
16. Students should attend the College prayer everyday without fail.
17. Students are advised to look into the notice board regularly for important announcements.

18. Use of Mobile Phones in the College is strictly prohibited. It will be confiscated if any one is found using it.
19. Attending events like College day, Talentsday, Inauguration of classes, Independence day, Republic day, Lectures of the Bangalore Science Forum and The Bangalore Social Science Forum and such other college functions is mandatory.

## 6 Scholarship's and Fee Concessions

## 8 Administration

The College is under the general administrative control of the Governing Council of The National Education Society of Karnataka. The Governing body with one representative from the Governing Council, the office bearers of the N.E.S., Principal of the National College, Basavanagudi, Secretary of the College Council

and a Teacher representative exercise supervision over the working of the College. Representation of the teaching staff in the Management of the College has been existing ever since the inception of the College. This democratic set up is one of the special features of the College Council. The Principal is the president of the College Council. All the teachers are members of the College Council.

## 9 Library



The College Library has been housed in the multi-storied building. The college Library consists of 90,000 books with an investment of Rs. 16.6 Lakhs. The Library is fully computerized with Barcode system. **Internet facility & E. Library are also available.** There is a qualified librarian in charge of the library. A well equipped Reference Section is housed in the first floor of the building. Besides the General Library, there are :

1. The Students Aid Society Book Bank sponsored by Sri. Ramanarayana Chellaram Charitable Trust and the Library Club of Bangalore.
2. Telang Trust library consisting of text books.
3. Poor Students' library.
4. Gandhi Library consisting of National literature (started with donation of Rs. 5000/- from the students of the college during the year 1963-64) and a matching grant of Rs. 5000/- from the college.

### Terms and conditions or borrowal of books

1. Students may borrow books from the library from Monday to Friday.
2. They may borrow two books at a time, on Barcode system.
3. A student should always possess the college identity card affixed with a passport size photograph duly attested by the Principal, Lib- Card must be produced at the time of borrowing books, both from Reference and Borrowing sections.

When the original I.D. Card is lost a duplicate I.D. Library Card will be issued on payment of Rs. 200-00 only.

4. Books should not be sub-lent
5. Any damage or destruction to the barcode label on the book or I.D. Card will involve a penalty of (Rs. 100-00) Rupees One Hundred only.
6. If any damage or destruction to the book or other property belonging to the library is caused by the borrower, he/she shall be required to replace such a book or other property damaged, or pay double the cost. If any volume of a set of book is damaged, the whole set of books must be replaced.

7. Dictionaries, Encyclopedias and such other books are meant for reference only.
8. (a) Books must be returned to the library on the 15th day from the date of borrowing. If books are not returned within the due date, an over due charge of One Rupee per day per book (as indicated by the computer) will be collected from the defaulter.  
(b) Books from book banks may be borrowed for a period of one year and may be returned at the end of the year.
9. (a) On the day of issue, he/she must inspect the pages and bring to the notice of the Library Staff any damage to the book that might have occurred already. Negligence to observe this rule will not be considered.  
(b) Library dues must be cleared immediately. Failure to do so will disqualify students from appearing for the examination.
10. Under special circumstances the Chief Librarian reserves the right to re-call a book before the date of expiry.
11. Any difficulty or grievances felt in utilizing the library should be brought to the notice of the Chief Librarian

### Reference Section

A selection of books for reference in all subjects is kept separately in the Reference

Section in the I floor of the Library Block. Reference Section works on all working days from 9-30 a.m. to 5-30 p.m. and on Saturdays between 9-30 a.m. to 2-00 p.m.



## 10 Tests and Examinations -----

In accordance with the rules framed by the Department of Pre-University Education the following tests and Examinations will be conducted and Marks Cards are sent to parents for information and needful action.

The performance in all these tests and examinations, as well as attendance will be taken into consideration while finalising the results of the I year Pre-University students.

The parents and guardians of the students are requested to meet the Principal atleast once in 3 months and ascertain the performance of their wards in tests and examinations. Only those students having 75% attendance in each subject are eligible to appear for final examinations.

## Special Remedial Coaching Classes

Special Coaching for Weak students in English and Core subjects will be conducted throughout the year, to encourage students for better academic performance.

## Role of Class Teachers

Each class will be personally monitored by a class teacher. He or she will act as local guardian for students and take note of their regularity, discipline and academic progress. The class teacher will also monitor his/her students constantly.

## Gandhi Study Circle

Gandhi Study Circle was established in the college in 1966. It has a well equipped library on Gandhian Literature. The library consists of about 6,500 books. The Scheme of intensive Study of National Literature is facilitated by this collection. Many well-wishers have contributed funds and books for the Gandhian Library.

## 11 N.C.C. -----

All able-bodied students, can join N.C.C. The college has been allotted one company each in Army Wing and Navy.

Further details about the enrolment, time table, discipline, etc. can be obtained from the concerned officers.



## Sports and Games

Facilities for playing Basket Ball, Cricket, Football, Hockey, Volleyball, Shuttle-Badminton, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Athletics, Ball, Badminton, Throw-ball, Tennicoit, Soft-ball and Tennis are provided.

We have a well equipped multi-gym and fitness centre for the use of students and members of the staff. Qualified staff are on the faculty of Sports Department and they organise various sports events.

The National College Health Centre is housed

in the closed Auditorium. Professional doctors conduct regular medical checkup. First Aid facility is available on all working days from 10-30 a.m. to 5 p.m.





## 14 The National College Hostel----

The college has a hostel, located in the same compound. Boarding and lodging facilities are provided for 70 boys. The charges are fixed on a

dividing basis. The administration of the Hostel is controlled by the N.E.S. The Principal is the ex-officio President of the Committee and a member of the staff shall be warden.



### Auditoria

The College has two large auditoria, each of which can accommodate about six hundred students. All important functions like, Inauguration of college activities, College Day, Drama Festival, Cultural Activities etc. are conducted in the Indoor Auditorium, which is also called Gandhi-Nehru Ranga Mandira. This auditorium has a big stage with a decorative outfits and side doors with ivory inlay. The other auditorium is an open air auditorium with a big stage.

Besides these two auditoria, the College has a large Multi media Seminar Hall named after Dr. H. Narasimhaiah. It is equipped with audio-visual facilities and has seating capacity for 300 people. The Bangalore Science Forum and The Bangalore Social Science Forum hold their meetings, regularly, inviting eminent guest speakers for the benefit of general public & students. Dr. H.N. Hall is also utilised for conducting cultural and other educative programmes.

3. The Transfer Certificate is not issued to a student, but it will be sent to the college or the institution in which the student has secured admission. Transfer Certificate will not be sent if the student has any dues to the college by way of fees, fines, breakage charges, books from the library, N.C.C. kit etc.
4. The Provisional Pass Certificate is issued by the college. Application should be made to the Principal in order to obtain the provisional certificate.
5. Copies of certificates may be attested by any Gazetted Officer or by the Head of Department of any college and not necessarily by the Principal.
6. Students applying for certificates, testimonials or any other documents requiring the Principal's signature should contact the concerned clerk before approaching the Principal.

## 15 Information to Parents and Students -----

1. Admission of students from one class to the next higher class is **Not Automatic**. It is subject to the satisfactory performance in the previous examination.
2. Every student **Must take a fresh application** seeking admission to the next higher class each year, attaching the marks card of the promotional examination conducted by the college.
3. **Students Selected** must pay the admission fee without fail at the time of admission.
4. The calendar for admission to different class will be announced on the Notice Board.
5. Names of the selected students will be entered in the register **Only After Admission and Payment of fees**.
6. Students will be **Interviewed** by the members of admission committee headed

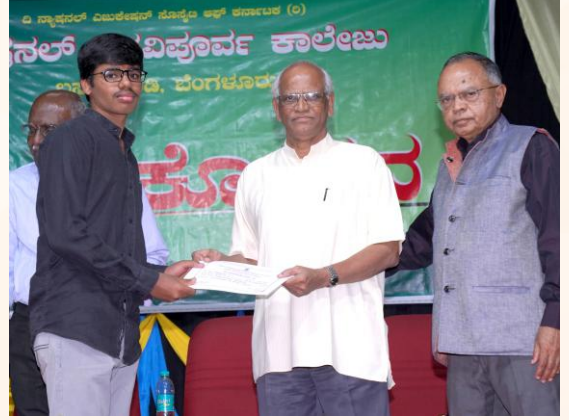

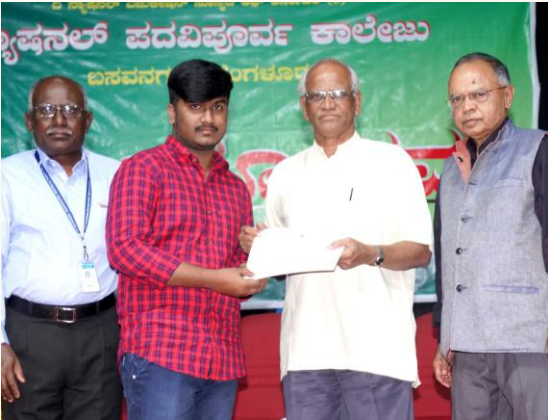
